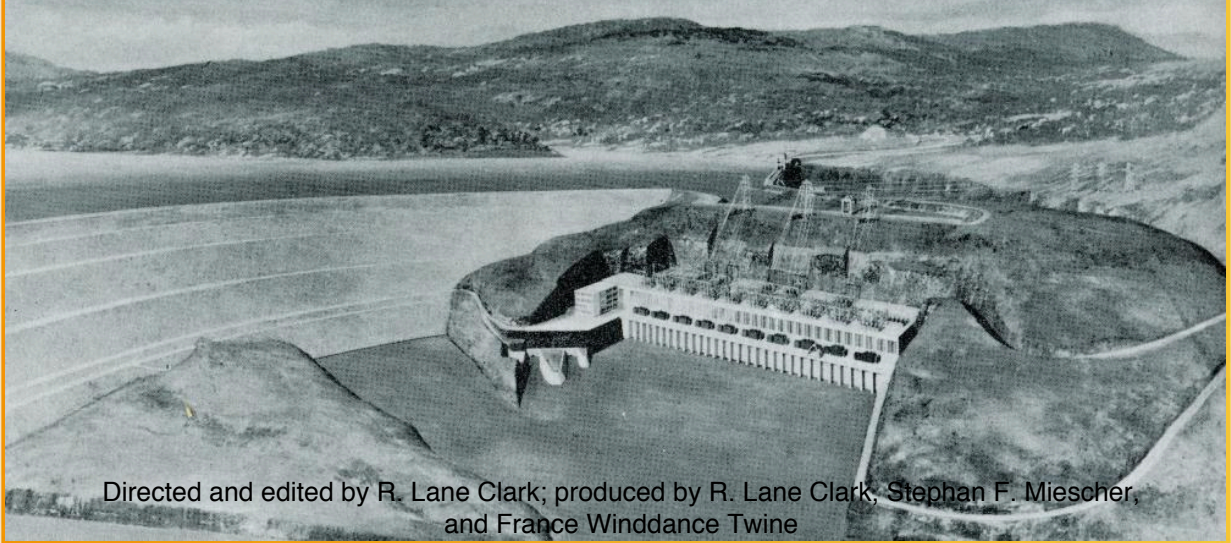


# Ghana's **Electric** Dreams
